

**PUBLIC HEARING
MINOCQUA BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
March 19th, 2019**

A Public Hearing of the Minocqua Board of Supervisors was called to order by Mark Hartzheim at 5:45 p.m. on March 19th, 2019 in the Board Room of the Minocqua Center to Consider a Petition For the Discontinuance of a Public Way described as – That certain platted Town Road approximately 30 feet wide, located between Lot 42 and Lot 43 in Block 1 of the recorded Plat of Bo Di Lac, Part of Govt. Lot 6, Section 8, T39N, R5E, extending from East Bakely Circle to Minocqua Parcel No. MI 2828-L, Town of Minocqua, Oneida County, Wisconsin. Said road is depicted on the Certified Survey Map prepared by Wilderness Surveying, Inc. and identified as Oneida county Certified Survey Map No. 004739.

Present were: Chairman Mark Hartzheim, Supervisors Sue Heil, Bill Stengl & John Thompson, Clerk Roben Haggart and Attorney Greg Harrold. Supervisor Fried was excused.

Motion by Heil, seconded by Thompson to approve the agenda as presented. Voice Vote: Motion Carried.

Greg Harrold reviewed the petition and the process for discontinuance of the portions of road as requested by Bryan Haack. The adjacent land owners, Haack & Westrick will each get 50% of platted road. There will need to be an easement agreement drafted to provide access to MI 2823 & MI 2822. The discontinuance of this road will not cause any parcels to be landlocked.

There was no public input.

Motion by Thompson, seconded by Heil to approve the Resolution for the discontinuance of town platted road approximately 30 feet wide, located between Lot 42 and Lot 43 in Block 1 of the recorded Plat of Bo Di Lac, Part of Govt. Lot 6, Section 8, T39N, R5E, extending from East Bakely Circle to Minocqua Parcel No. MI 2828-L contingent upon all parties entering into a written easement agreement providing access to MI 2823 & MI 2822. Voice Vote: Motion Carried.

Motion by Stengl, seconded by Heil to adjourn meeting. Voice Vote: Motion Carried. Meeting adjourned at 5:55 p.m.
