Application/License for Dogs

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR DOG OWNERS:

Dogs running at large and untagged dogs subject to penalties; impoundment. A dog is considered to be running at large if it is off the premises of its owner and not under the control of the owner or some other person. A dog that is actively engaged in a legal hunting activity, including training, is not considered to be running at large if the dog is monitored or supervised by a person and the dog is on land that is open to hunting or on land on which the person has obtained permission to hunt or to train a dog. A dog is considered to be untagged if a valid license tag is not attached to a collar which is kept on the dog whenever the dog is outdoors unless the dog is securely confined in a fenced area. If the owner of a dog negligently or otherwise permits the dog to run at large or be untagged, the owner shall forfeit not less than \$25 nor more than \$100 for the first offense and not less than \$50 nor more than \$200 for subsequent offenses. There may be additional costs for owners to recover an impounded dog from the pound.

Dog licenses and collar tags. A dog license is necessary for the keeping of any dog over 5 months of age. Upon payment of the required dog license tax and, upon presentation of evidence that the dog is currently immunized against rabies, the collecting official shall complete and issue to the owner a license for the dog bearing a serial number and in the form prescribed by the department stating the date of its expiration, the owner's name and address, and the name, sex, spayed or unspayed, neutered or unneutered, breed and color of the dog. After issuing the license the collecting official shall deliver to the owner a tag of durable material bearing the same serial number as the license, the name of the county in which issued and the license year. The owner shall securely attach the tag to a collar and a collar with the tag attached shall be kept on the dog for which the license is issued at all times but this requirement does not apply to a dog during competition or training, to a dog securely confined indoors, to a dog while hunting, to a dog securely confined area.

Barking dogs. It is unlawful for any person knowingly to keep or harbor any dog which habitually barks, howls or yelps, to the great discomfort of the peace and quiet of the neighborhood, or in such manner as to materially disturb or annoy persons in the neighborhood who are of ordinary sensibilities. Such dogs are declared to be a public nuisance. Violation forfeiture: not less than \$25 plus the costs of prosecution.

Pet waste. It is unlawful for any person to cause or permit a dog or cat to be on property, public or private, not owned or possessed by such person, unless such person has in his immediate possession an appropriate device for scooping excrement and an appropriate depository for the transmission of excrement to a receptacle. Violation forfeiture: not less than \$25 plus the costs of prosecution.



When you license your dog, the fees directly support the Oneida County Humane Society (OCHS) and the services they provide, like keeping stray pets safe and helping them find their way home.
