Minocqua's "Spring Clean-Up Week"

May 11, 2026

The Town of Minocqua has traditionally offered "Spring Clean-Up Week" each year for residents to have their yard debris picked up and disposed of free of charge. Please be aware that this service is provided for removal of ordinary yard debris like leaves, pine needles, pine cones, twigs and small branches. (The service is not provided for woodlot cleanup, German forestry, or large storm debris.)

At this time, Spring Clean-Up Week is scheduled for May 11, 2026.

To ensure pickup, residents' yard debris must be placed at the roadside by 8:00 A.M. on May 11, 2026. Crews will only make one pass through each area, no return trips will be made to individual residences.

IMPORTANT REQUIREMENTS THAT MUST BE FOLLOWED TO PARTICIPATE IN PROGRAM:

- Debris must be placed at the nearest Town, County, State or U.S. road (debris will not be picked up from private roads or easements) by 8:00 A.M. on May 11, 2026
- Leaves, needles, pine cones, etc., must be bagged
- No logs, trunks or stumps larger than 6 inches in diameter
- Maximum length for any material is 8 feet
- Do not place debris piles underneath overhead lines or other obstructions if there are other options
- Make debris piles as compact as possible; if debris requires multiple stacks or piles, arrange them parallel with the roadway (running along the road, not perpendicular to the road)
- Spring Clean-Up service is intended for **ordinary yard debris only** (bagged leaves and pine needles, twigs, small branches); **it is not meant for large stumps, trunks or excessive amounts of material (if it looks like more than two pickup truck loads, it's too much!)**
- Pickup is limited to naturally-occurring materials only (no lumber or other construction materials, no man-made or processed items)
- Debris being picked up must be from that address; do not bring in materials from other locations
- Crews cannot make return trips to pick up debris that was not placed at the roadside on time. Don't take chances! Make certain your lawn debris is placed roadside by 8:00 A.M. on May 11, 2026!

**In order to keep costs down, the above requirements are strictly enforced.
