LIBRARY

Peg O'Connell and Pat Pechura presented the 2021 budget proposal for the Minocqua Public Library. The budget is up a little from last year due to salary increases. They also discussed the library revenue sources and amounts.

COMMUNITY ASSETS

Representatives from the following organizations were present to discuss their 2021 budget requests; Lakeland Senior Center; Minocqua/Kawaguesaga Lake Protection Association; Tomahawk Lake Property Owners Association; Minocqua Winter Park and Oneida County Economic Development Corp. The board was able to discuss and asked questions to each of the representatives.

Motion by Stengl, seconded by Heil to release an additional \$2,000 to the senior center out of the 2020 budget allocation. Voice Vote: Motion Carried.
