

**PUBLIC HEARING
MINOCQUA BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
September 15th, 2020**

A Public Hearing of the Minocqua Board of Supervisors was called to order by Mark Hartzheim at 5:45 p.m. on September 15th, 2020 in the Board Room of the Minocqua Center to Consider a Petition For the Discontinuance of a Public Way described as – All of Brooker Road as shown on that certain survey map prepared by Foltz and Associates, Inc. dated December 12th, 1996 from Streater Road to a point approximately 200’ west and north of Agawak and Blue Lake Point Road intersection. A map of Brooker Road as described above is on file with the Town Clerk.

Present were: Chairman Mark Hartzheim, Supervisors Sue Heil, Bill Stengl, Bill Fricke & John Thompson, Clerk Roben Haggart, Mark Pertile, Director of Public Works, Mary Fried, petitioner and Attorney Greg Harrold.

Motion by Heil, seconded by Thompson to approve the agenda as presented. Voice Vote: Motion Carried.

Greg Harrold reviewed the petition and the process for the request to discontinue Brooker Road. In addition to Mary Fried, one other land owner will be affected. Mary has been working with them and now feels that they are on board with the proposal. If for some reason they change their minds in the next 30 days, a new petition would be drafted showing only a portion of the road being discontinued. Mary was pretty certain that this would not be the case.

There was no other public input.

Motion by Fricke, seconded by Thompson to approve the Petition for the Discontinuance of a Public Way described as – All of Brooker Road as shown on that certain survey map prepared by Foltz and Associates, Inc. dated December 12th, 1996 from Streater Road to a point approximately 200’ west and north of Agawak and Blue Lake Point Road intersection contingent upon a survey being completed to confirm the 200’. Voice Vote: Motion Carried.

Motion by Stengl, seconded by Thompson to adjourn meeting. Voice Vote: Motion Carried. Meeting adjourned at 5:55 p.m.
