

**PUBLIC HEARING  
MINOCQUA BOARD OF SUPERVISORS  
December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020**

A Public Hearing of the Minocqua Board of Supervisors was called to order by Mark Hartzheim at 5:45 p.m. on December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020 in the Board Room of the Minocqua Center to Consider a Petition For the Discontinuance of a Public Way described as – All of Brooker Road as shown on that certain survey map prepared by Foltz and Associates, Inc. dated December 12<sup>th</sup>, 1996 from Streater Road to the Agawak and Blue Lake Point Road intersection. A map of Brooker Road as described above is on file with the Town Clerk.

Present were: Chairman Mark Hartzheim, Supervisors Sue Heil, Bill Fricke & John Thompson, Clerk Roben Haggart, Mark Pertile, Director of Public Works, Mary Fried, petitioner and Attorney Greg Harrold. Supervisor Stengl was excused.

**Motion by Heil, seconded by Thompson to approve the agenda as presented.** Voice Vote: Motion Carried.

Greg Harrold reviewed the petition and the process for the request to discontinue Brooker Road. In addition to Mary Fried, one other land owner will be affected. Mary has been working with the Dietrich-Reck family and they are now on board to vacate the entire road. This was previously approved and then revised to only include a portion of the road. It is now back to the original petition to vacate the entire road.

There was no other public input.
