

**REGULAR MEETING
MINOCQUA BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
December 1st, 2020**

A regular meeting of the Minocqua Board of Supervisors was called to order by Chairman Mark Hartzheim at 6:00 p.m. on December 1st, 2020 in the Board Room of the Minocqua Center.

Present were: Chairman Mark Hartzheim, Supervisors Brian Fricke, Sue Heil & John Thompson, Mark Pertile, Director of Public Works, David Jaeger, Minocqua Chief of Police and five audience members. Supervisor Stengl was excused.

Motion by Thompson, seconded by Fricke to approve the agenda. Voice vote: Motion carried.

Motion by Thompson, seconded by Fricke to approve the minutes from the Regular Town Board Meetings held on October 20th & November 4th, Special Town Meeting Board Meeting held on November 10th, 2020 and Annual Budget Meeting held on November 19th, 2020. Voice Vote: Motion Carried.

NEW BUSINESS

MINOCQUA LAKE TO LAKE TOMAHAWK CHANNEL – SLOW-NO-WAKE

A request for the board to consider designating the entire channel from Minocqua Lake to Tomahawk Lake as slow-no-wake was discussed. Clerk Haggart advised that there were approximately 51 emails received with 42 being in favor of the slow-no-wake designation and 9 against. There was a lot of discussion and public comment on the channel as well as the entire lake specifically between the trestles on Lake Minocqua. The increased size of boats and motors along with the amount of boaters has contributed to the concerns. Additional enforcement is needed in these areas. The board decided to get more feedback/input before making a final decision. This item will be on a future board agenda.

CLASS B COMBINATION LIQUOR LICENSE – THE PUBLIC HOUSE

Clerk Roben Haggart presented a Class B Combination Liquor License application from the Public House, LLC, Jolene Sandberg, agent, 8130 Highway 51 South for approval. This license would be a reserve license in the amount of \$10,000. Jolene reviewed her business plan and answered questions from the board.

Motion by Fricke, seconded by Thompson to approve the Class B Combination liquor license application from Jolene Sandberg for the property located at 8130 Highway 51 South. Should the business at that premise cease to exist, the license would revert back to the town. Voice Vote: Motion Carried.

Motion by Thompson, seconded by Fricke to adjourn meeting. Voice Vote: Motion Carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:15 p.m.
