## MINOCQUA FIRE DEPARTMENT

Minocqua Fire Chief Rich Carani presented his 2026 budget request. The board also discussed taking out a loan in 2026 for a new fire truck.

## MINOCQUA POLICE DEPARTMENT

The board reviewed the police department 2026 budget proposal. Adjustments were made on some line items. Chief Janzer is still working through the line item for technology and computer maintenance. Supervisor Fried suggested that Glenn reach out too Oneida County to see if they can help with the costs. The board talked about the squad car replacement plan.

Glenn also mentioned that the water patrol boat needs to be replaced. He was hoping to buy one in 2025 with the excess department surplus. He is looking at around \$48,000 which will be partially re-imbursed by the DNR grant.

Motion by Fricke, seconded by Petersen authorizing the police chief to obtain quotes for a new water patrol boat. Voice Vote: Motion Carried. Supervisor Fried voted nay.
