

**SPECIAL MEETING
OPERATORS LICENSE HEARING
MINOCQUA BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
May 5th, 2026**

A special meeting of the Minocqua Board of Supervisors was called to order by Chairman Mark Hartzheim at 4:30 p.m. on May 5th, 2026 in the Board Room of the Minocqua Center for the purpose of conducting a hearing for the denial of an operator license for Kelly Seeliger.

Present were: Chairman Mark Hartzheim, Supervisors Lance Krolczyk, Erika Petersen, Brian Fricke & Billy Fried; Police Chief Glen Janzer and Clerk Roben Haggart.

Motion by Fried, seconded by Fricke to approve the agenda as presented. Voice Vote: Motion Carried.

OPERATOR LICENSE HEARING

Chief Glenn Janzer presented his reason for recommending denial of the operator's license application for Kelly Seeliger. She has several OWI convictions with the current being in 2021. She currently has restrictions on her drivers license of .02 BAC which is a result of her OWI convictions. She has also been convicted for operation after revocation which was a result of her OWI conviction. Having multiple alcohol related convictions, Chief Janzer is recommending denial. Ms. Seeliger gave her reasons for her appeal and answered questions from the board. Kelly is opening up a flower shop and would like to sell wine/liquor in gift baskets for off-premise consumption. Supervisor Fried suggested that Kelly re-apply after one year of a clean record.

Motion by Fried, seconded by Krolczyk to uphold the chief's recommendation to deny the Operator License application for Kelly Seeliger. Voice Vote: Motion Carried. Supervisor Fricke voted nay.

Motion by Fricke, seconded by Fried to adjourn meeting. Voice Vote: Motion Carried. Meeting adjourned at 5:00 p.m.
